Referendum Results

Health Center Fee

Voting completed: 4/3/2025 5:00:00 PM

The University Health Center (UHC) provides essential medical and wellness services to University of Maryland students and is funded through a combination of insurance payments, direct patient payments, and the university's operating budget. Governor Wes Moores fiscal year 2026 proposed budget would reduce funding for the university system by \$111 million. Further, the UHC finds itself in a budget deficit. The present projections are based on fiscal year 2026 and any changes to the fee would require student approval.

Do you support the implementation of a mandatory health center fee, estimated to be approximately \$140-180 per year for full-time students and \$70-90 per year for part-time students, to replace individual service charges and co-pays for specific University Health Center (UHC) services? A Yes vote WOULD support the implementation of the above fee rate, which would eliminate out-of-pocket costs for UMD students for the covered services while adding student representation in UHC budget deliberations and service offerings, enhancing privacy, simplifying access, and potentially reducing the Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) costs. A No vote WOULD NOT support the implementation of the above fee rate, which would decrease current operations and service offerings at the UHC, continue a pay-per-service model that relies on (potentially out-of-network) insurance, and lead to potential SHIP increases.
